Dr M to visit Brunei for annual talks

KUALA LUMPUR, Wed. - Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad will be making a two-day working visit to Brunei from Friday for the sixth annual consultation between the Prime Minister and Sultan Hassanal Bolkiah.

It is Brunei's turn to host the annual consultation this year.

Wisma Putra, in a statement today, said Dr Mahathir was expected to discuss bilateral as well as regional and international issues of common concern with the Sultan of Brunei. Sultan Hassanal will also host a dinner in honour of Dr Mahathir's visit.

Dr Mahathir, to be accompanied by his wife Datuk Seri Dr Siti Hasmah Mohd Ali, Foreign Minister Datuk Seri Syed Hamid Albar and senior government officials, will meet the Malaysian community in Brunei before returning home on Sunday.
