Any problems can be resolved, says Abdullah

KUALA LUMPUR, Wed. - Umno deputy president Datuk Seri Abdullah Ahmad Badawi expressed confidence that any problems in the party can be resolved without creating friction among the leaders.

Abdullah said they could consult one another when undertaking tasks or implementing programmes for the party.

He said Umno management committee met weekly to discuss problems that arose.

"We can discuss all party matters at these meetings. We have good teamwork. This is the best approach," he said when asked to comment on Umno president Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad's advice that there should be no power struggle among party leaders during the transition period.

Abdullah said co-operation was the most suitable approach.
