There's limit to BN leaders' patience, Syed Razak warns Pas

ALOR STAR, Tues. - Menteri Besar Datuk Seri Syed Razak Syed Zain today warned Pas leaders against testing the Government's patience by continuing with their verbal abuse and slander campaigns against Barisan Nasional leaders.

He said the Government had so far been patient with Pas leaders who had used harsh and vulgar language against BN leaders, especially Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad.

"When they maki us, we keep quiet. But there's a limit to our patience," he said after performing a ground breaking ceremony for a five-star hotel project here.

"If we turn around and do the same thing... then the rakyat shouldn't blame us."

He reminded the people of their role to put an end to the unhealthy trend before it becomes a norm. He said they could do this by rejecting parties which promoted such a practice.

"On our part, we will continue to expose Pas leaders who like to do this in their ceramah.

"We'll let the people know and decide who they want as their leaders," he said.

"If they still choose these people, then they are also encouraging this bad behaviour."

On the hotel project, Syed Razak said it was part of the State Government's plan to provide up market accommodation for the middle and upper class travellers and businessmen.

The Berjaya Perdana Suites is a project by Berjaya Group Berhad through its subsidiary Berjaya Hotel and Resorts.

The RM70 million project combines a new concept of a hotel with facilities of service apartments-cum-office suites for businessmen.

It will have 80 boutique hotel rooms, 100 office suites, a spa as well as banquet facilities for some 1,000 people.

Syed Razak said the project would help spur growth here and complement other development projects such as the Mini Putrajaya in Anak Bukit as well as the RM20 million yacht club and marina in Kuala Kedah.
