Assembly endorses peace formula

A RESOLUTION to fully support the party's peace and stability formula was passed by the Wanita MCA annual assembly yesterday.

The resolution also called for party leaders at all levels to close ranks to maintain unity in the party and the nation.

The party's peace formula which was proposed by Barisan Nasional chairman Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad when he was asked by the MCA leadership to intervene in finding a solution to its internal problems.

The formula was later endorsed by the party's central committee.

The peace formula states that the status quo should remain. There is also no vacancy in all posts, including in the central committee. This means that there will be no election.

Seventeen other resolutions were also passed. They covered politics, party affairs, women, education, economy, social matters and environment/health.

Among the other resolutions passed were:

- * urging the party to request from Barisan Nasional allocation of parliamentary and state assembly seats during the redelineation of constituencies,

- * urging the Prime Minister to appoint more Wanita MCA representatives to government posts including that of Deputy Minister for the Women and Family Development Ministry.
