SC-APPOINTMENT
ABDUL ALIM APPOINTED SC MEMBER

KUALA LUMPUR, May 20 (Bernama) -- The chief executive officer (CEO) of the Companies Commission of Malaysia, Abdul Alim Abdullah (formerly the registrar of companies), has been appointed as a commission member of the Securities Commission (SC) effective May 18, 2002, the SC announced here today.

Abdul Alim, 53, a Barrister-at-law (Lincoln's Inn London) replaced Habibah Abdul, who was appointed as SC commission member on May 18, 1999, the SC said in a statement here today.

Prior to joining the Companies Commission of Malaysia on April 1, 2002, Abdul Alim was the Chairman of the Kuala Lumpur Industrial Court.

He has also served as the Legal Adviser for the Ministry of Home Affairs (1996-2000) as well as the Johor State Government Legal Adviser (1992-1996).

His appointment was made by Finance Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad who is the Prime Minister, in line with Section 4 of the Securities Commission Act 1993. -- BERNAMA
