DAP's Lim calls for terrorism debate

PENANG, Fri. - Lim Kit Siang today called on Parliament not to end its meeting next week without comprehensively debating terrorism.

To do otherwise meant Parliament would have abdicated its fundamental responsibility as the highest political forum in the country.
