KUALA LUMPUR, Wed. - Some 300 children from various charitable homes will have an evening of fun and entertainment at the One Nation We Care event, thanks to Hong Leong Foundation.

They are from Pure Life Society, Shelter Homes, Rumah Ozanam, Ti Ratana Welfare Home and Rumah Bakti.

Hong Leong Foundation director Datuk Roger Tan said: "In addition to transportation and the opportunity to spend an evening with Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad, we have bought the children raffle tickets worth RM2 each."
