CONFERENCE OF RULERS' MEETING DISCUSSES SECURITY ISSUES

KUALA LUMPUR, Oct 31 (Bernama) -- The two-day 195th meeting of the Conference of Rulers which ended here today discussed matters pertaining to the nation's security and the economic situation.

The meeting, attended by the Yang di-Pertuan Agong Tuanku Syed Sirajuddin Syed Putra Jamalullail today, also discussed issues relating to religion and appointments.

Tuanku Syed Sirajuddin was accompanied by Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad, according to the Keeper of the Rulers' Seal, Engku Tan Sri Ibrahim Engku Ngah in a statement issued here today.

Present at the meeting were all the Rulers except the Sultan of Perak who was represented by the Regent of Perak Raja Dr Nazrin Shah, the Sultan of Johor who was represented by the Tengku Mahkota of Johor Tunku Ibrahim Ismail and the Sultan of Kedah who was represented by the Tunku Bendahara of Kedah Datuk Seri Tunku Annuar.

All the Yang Dipertuas Negeri were present.

The meeting was chaired by the Sultan of Selangor Sultan Sharafuddin Idris Shah.
