DAP practising double standards, says PPP president

KUALA LUMPUR, Sun. - The DAP is practising double standards if it thinks it cannot be criticised when it has always been good at attacking the Government, said People's Progressive Party president Datuk M. Kayveas.

"They (the DAP) should not be above criticism. What is so special about them that they cannot be criticised? If they think they can criticise people, then they themselves should be prepared to accept criticisms."

Kayveas was responding to a statement by DAP deputy national chairman Karpal Singh who on Friday, said it was wrong for Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad to criticise the party for its campaign against Dr Mahathir's declaration that Malaysia was an Islamic State.

Kayveas said if the DAP was sincerely against an Islamic State, then it should sever all ties with Pas.
