DPM tells police to act against Bunyamin

BUTTERWORTH, Mon. - Datuk Seri Abdullah Ahmad Badawi today directed the police to act against former Pas Bachok MP Bunyamin Yaacob for alleging that Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad had watched a pornographic video with his grandchildren.

Describing the allegation as insolent, the Deputy Prime Minister said Pas was adamant in instilling hatred in the people against the Prime Minister.

"They are really going out of their way to make the people hate Dr Mahathir," Abdullah said after opening the RM2.COM franchise training centre at Pacific Megamall here.

"However, I know there are many Malaysians who love and respect the Prime Minister."

He was asked to comment on a video clipping, aired by Radio Televisyen Malaysia recently, which showed Bunyamin telling a large audience that Dr Mahathir had watched a pornographic video with his grandchildren.

Meanwhile, Abdullah said soldiers should use their experiences and knowledge in food preparation, maintenance of heavy vehicles and jungle survival skill to generate income in future.

He said their experiences in the respective fields would enable them to set up a chain of eating shops, motor workshops and eco-tourism guide service.

He said there was good potential to develop these three business sectors as the soldiers, especially those who had retired from the service, had the skill, knowledge and capability to carry out the business.

Abdullah suggested that soldiers who had the skill in food preparation set up a chain of restaurants by offering cheap food, that is RM2 for a plate of rice with three dishes.
