DR M HELD IN HIGH ESTEEM FOR HIS SINCERE, FORGIVING ATTITUDE

MARAN, Pahang, Sept 30 (Bernama) -- Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamed's willingness to forgive someone who had publicly humiliated him by saying that he cannot read the Al Quran proves that he is a sincere leader with no desire for vengeance, Pahang Deputy Menteri Besar Datuk Tan Aminuddin Ishak said.

He was commenting on the Prime Minister's statement that he forgave Kelantan Menteri Besar Datuk Nik Abdul Aziz Nik Mat for saying such things while delivering a political ceramah at Bachok recently.

Tan Aminuddin, who is the Maran Umno Division head, said the PAS leader should realise that humiliating others in public amounted to a big sin.

Speaking to reporters after opening the Maran Umno Division Puteri Umno delegates conference here last night, he said people who made use of religion to advance their political interests should repent for their offences.
