BEHAVE WELL, ADHERE TO RULES AND REGULATIONS, BN MEMBERS TOLD

KOTA KINABALU, Oct 2 (Bernama) -- Barisan Nasional (BN) component party members and its election machinery workers have been asked to behave well and observe the rules and regulations in the Gaya parliamentary by-election.

BN secretary-general Tan Sri Mohamed Rahmat said Prime Minister and BN chairman Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad had entrusted him with the task of ensuring component party members behaved and conduct themselves well during the by-election period.
