Gerakan, MCA plan to counter DAP allegations

SEREMBAN, Sun. - Gerakan will work together with MCA to stop DAP from misleading the Chinese community by playing up the issue of Malaysia as an Islamic country.

Gerakan president Datuk Seri Dr Lim Keng Yaik said the issue was being used as the latest political tactic by DAP and it was evident in the political speeches of some top DAP leaders.

Dr Lim said this was following the declaration of Malaysia as an Islamic country by Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad in a Gerakan national convention last year.

"I believe DAP is misleading and confusing the Chinese community for its own political ends and not in the interest of unity and democracy," he said at a briefing at Wisma Gerakan here, today.

He said that since Gerakan is a component of Barisan Nasional, it will work together with MCA to disseminate the correct information to the Chinese community regarding the issue of Malaysia as an Islamic country.
