KART RACE: MALAYSIA LISTS TWO MORE DRIVERS

LANGKAWI, Jan 8 (Bernama) -- Malaysia has listed two more drivers to represent the country at the second edition of the Rotax Max Kart Championship grand final at the Morac International Kart circuit here from Jan 25 to 27.

Mofaz Group chief operating officer Ahmad Tifli Talha said today with the listing of the two drivers, Mahathir Ngaau and Rodney Mangness, Malaysia would have five representatives at the championship.

As the organisers, Malaysia could have two additional drivers, he said when inspecting preparations for the championship here.

This is the first time Malaysia, and Langkawi in particular, has been chosen to host the final leg of the Rotax Max Kart Championship which would draw more tourists to the resort island.

The prestigious championship is being organised by Mofaz Motorsport, Langkawi Development Authority (Lada) and Langkawi Motorsport Club (LMC).

Ahmad Tifli, who is also championship coordinator, said Ferhan Fauzy, Raja Razman Raja Idris and Martin Druhan had earlier been selected to represent Malaysia in the race.

He said the first edition of the race was held in Puerto Rico last year with Gavin Grinje from South Africa clinching the title.
