KUALA LUMPUR, Feb 6 (Bernama) -- The Yang di-Pertuan Agong Tuanku Syed Sirajuddin Putra Jamalullail has congratulated Governor-General Daniel C. Williams on the occasion of Grenada's independence anniversary.
