Keng Yaik to show proof of instigation

KUALA LUMPUR, Tues. - Gerakan president Datuk Seri Dr Lim Keng Yaik said today he would present proof that Penang State MCA chairman Wong Kam Hoong had instigated the actions of the two suspended Penang State assemblymen, at the Barisan Nasional supreme council meeting next month.

"Let them deny this as much as they want. The more they deny it, the more proof we will come up with," he said.

"Everyone knows that their main intention is to undermine the Gerakan leadership in Penang under Chief Minister Tan Sri Dr Koh Tsu Koon."

Asked if he would meet Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad personally before raising the matter at the BN supreme council, Dr Lim said there was no reason to as MCA was a BN component party and this should be heard and discussed by all component parties.
