UMNO'S ACTION PLAN AGAINST PHANTOM AND IMPORT VOTERS

KUALA TERENGGANU, Sept 5 (Bernama) -- Umno will come out with an action plan to counter phantom and import voters in preparation for the next general election, said its secretary-general Tan Sri Khalil Yaakob today.

He said a Supreme Council permanent committee headed by vice-president Datuk Seri Mohd Najib Tun Abdul Razak would be responsible for formulating the action plan.

"Umno president, Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad has asked the vice-president to prepare the action plan," he said when asked to comment on Election Commission (SPR) Chairman Datuk Abdul Rashid Abdul Rahman's statement yesterday that Kelantan, Terengganu, Kedah and Pahang had the most number of import voters.

Speaking to reporters after officiating Radio Malaysia Terengganu (RMT) Open Day here, Khalil said the action plan would serve as the guidelines for Umno and the Barisan Nasional (BN) in countering the problem of phantom and import voters.
