M'SIA HOSTS COMMONWEALTH AUDIT CHIEFS CONFERENCE IN OCT

KUALA LUMPUR, Sept 24 (Bernama) -- A two-day Commonwealth National Audit Chiefs Conference will be held in Malaysia starting Oct 7.

Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad is expected to launch the event at the Palace of the Golden Horses.

This year's theme is "Re-Engineering Auditing in the Public Sector". The prestigious event is held to step up cooperation among the Commonwealth national audit chiefs and improve their knowledge and professionalism in auditing and international finance.

It also sought to enhance the participants' knowledge in the latest audit methodologies.

The conference's 150 participants also include auditors and senior officers from the Asian Organisation of Supreme Audit Institutions, International Organisations of Supreme Audit Institutions and professional accounting agencies in Malaysia.

This is the second time Malaysia is playing host for the conference held once every three years. Kuala Lumpur hosted the first conference in 1975.
