SUFFICIENT EVIDENCE TO INDICT BUNİYAMIN

KUALA LUMPUR, Sept 5 (Bernama) -- Kelantan PAS Information Chief Buniyamin Yaacob will be charged in court for his defamatory statements against Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad.

The Attorney-General's (AG) Chamber in a statement today said the Public Prosecutor after having carefully studied the investigation papers submitted by the police today was satisfied with the evidence attributing to Buniyamin which is "clearly defamatory of the character of Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad."

"Instruction has been given to the police to bring Buniyamin bin Yaacob before the court for him to be charged by the Prosecution Division of the Attorney General's Chambers," it said.

It said the AG's office had decided to issue this statement in view of the seriousness of the allegations by Buniyamin, and the public interest which had been generated over his statement.

Buniyamin at a ceramah at Pusat Tarbiyah Islamiah Kelantan (Putik), Pengkalan Chepa, Kelantan on last March 15 was alleged to have said that Dr Mahathir had watched porn video with his grandson.
