No visitors allowed at PM's residence

THE situation outside Seri Perdana, Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad's official residence in Putrajaya last night was quiet.

According to police guards at the entrance, Dr Mahathir did not want to receive any visitors, including Cabinet Ministers.

A Deputy Minister who arrived at about 9.30pm was turned away.

The only people allowed entry into the compound were family members.

The security at Seri Perdana was also bolstered with additional personnel from the Putrajaya district police, whose chief Deputy Superintendent Kamal Kordi was also present.
