`Video clippings won't sway votes'

ALOR STAR, Sat. - Pas today said the video clippings currently being aired by Radio Televisyen Malaysia will have no impact on Pendang and Anak Bukit voters, but instead gave free publicity to the "actors".

Its information chief, Azizan Abdul Razak, said Malaysians are so used to seeing such Barisan Nasional election propaganda and would not be easily influenced.

Azizan, who is also Kedah Pas Commissioner, said BN should know by now that the same tactics they used during the past by-elections were ineffective.

"We are not bothered about it. Our concern is to concentrate on our own campaign.

"All we have to say is a big thank you to RTM for giving free publicity to Shahnnon and Mohd Sabu," he said, referring to the clippings showing Sik Member of Parliament Datuk Shahnnon Ahmad and Kuala Kedah MP Mohd Sabu condemning Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad and his deputy Datuk Seri Abdullah Ahmad Badawi.

Azizan was speaking at the launching of the Pas Youth election machinery at Gajah Mati in Pendang.
