Opposition rapped for false accusations

PENDANG, Sun. - Opposition leaders who are in the habit of swearing at others should realise they are less than perfect, said Barisan Nasional Youth chairman Datuk Hishammuddin Hussein.

Umno Youth chief Hishammuddin said Pas leaders who resorted to name-calling and unfounded accusations against Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad were in no position to judge others.
