A-G waits for report on Mohamad Sabu

SEREMBAN, Tues. - Attorney-General Datuk Abdul Gani Patail said he would decide on action to be taken against Pas' Kuala Kedah MP Mohamad Sabu when he receives a report from the police.

Radio Televisyen Malaysia (RTM) had for the past few days been airing clippings of a Pas ceramah where Mohamad Sabu, who is also deputy Kedah Commissioner, had insulted Umno leaders.

Abdul Gani said if there was sufficient evidence to show that an offence had been committed, action would be taken against Mohamad Sabu.

"We need to study all aspects before taking any action. Personally, I have not received any report on this."

Abdul Gani was asked whether action would be taken against Mohamad Sabu for using vulgarity against Umno leaders, including calling president Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad and deputy president Datuk Seri Abdullah Ahmad Badawi "haprak".
