Pahang MCA backs Maths, Science move

KUANTAN, Sun. - The Pahang MCA supports the Government's proposal to teach Science and Mathematics in English as it is with the State Barisan Nasional in passing a resolution on this.

Pahang Menteri Besar Datuk Seri Adnan Yaakob, saying this today, added that he did not see any conflict arising from this although the MCA central committee was against the proposal.

"Pahang MCA supports the resolution passed today," he said at the conclusion of the Pahang BN convention here. The State BN also passed another resolution calling on the United Nations to erase all records linking BN to al-Qaeda.

Both resolutions got unanimous support from all six BN component parties in the State - Umno, MCA, MIC, Gerakan and People's Progressive Party.

Adnan said the Pahang BN fully supported the decision to teach Science and Mathematics in English in all primary schools next year after getting feedback from all parties.

He was speaking at the convention at the Dewan Jubli Perak Sultan Haji Ahmad Shah, here, today.

Also present were Umno vice-president Datuk Seri Najib Tun Razak, Umno secretary-general Tan Sri Khalil Yaakob and Pahang MCA chairman Datuk Chan Kong Choy.

According to Adnan, there had been mixed reactions since the proposal to teach Science and Mathematics in English was made.

"This is why, Pahang BN believes that Dr Mahathir and the Cabinet would wisely overcome all the problems pertaining to the matter," he said.

Adnan also called on the Government to persuade the UN to erase all records which connected BN with the al-Qaeda movement, as the reference material used by the international body had yet to be proven.
