PRIME MINISTER TO DELIVER WORKERS DAY MESSAGE

KUALA LUMPUR, April 29 (Bernama) -- Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad will address civil servants at a rally at the National Institute of Public Administration (Intan) in Bukit Kiara, here, in conjunction with the Workers Day celebration on Wednesday.

He will deliver his Workers Day message to about 800 people including the secretaries-general of the ministries, heads of department and members of Cuepacs affiliates and the National Joint Council (NJC).

Cuepacs secretary-general Abdul Rahman Manan said in a statement here today that the rally was jointly organised by the Public Service Department (PSD), Intan and Cuepacs.

Minister in the Prime Minister's Department Tan Sri Bernard Dompok, Human Resources Minister Datuk Dr Fong Chan Onn, Chief Secretary to the Government Tan Sri Samsudin Osman and PSD Director-general Datuk Seri Jamaluddin Ahmad Damanhuri would attend the function which would give the workers' representatives a chance to discuss current issues in the public sector.

Abdul Rahman said Radio Television Malaysia would telecast Dr Mahathir's speech live.

He said Cuepacs and PSD would also conduct a basic course for 350 leaders and members of Cuepacs affiliates and the NJC tomorrow and there would also be a meeting of the Cuepacs council and a dinner.
