## SP Setia leads in landscaping

BUKIT Indah (Johor) Sdn Bhd, a wholly owned subsidiary of S P Setia Bhd has bagged the National Landscape Award 2001 under the Neighbourhood Park category for its Bukit Indah township in Bandar Nusajaya, Johor Baru.

Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad presented the award to S P Setia chairman Datuk Abdul Rashid Abdul Manaff on March 3 at a ceremony held in conjunction with the National Landscaping Day in KLCC, Kuala Lumpur.

S P Setia's signature neighbourhood parks in Bukit Indah and other development projects have also received recognition from the respective local authorities.

For example, Bukit Indah Johor won the Johor Landscape Award 2001 while Bukit Indah Ampang emerged the first runner-up in a similar award from the Ampang Jaya Municipal Council.

Bukit Indah is modelled after the award-winning Australian Green Street concept, which combines the elements of clean and healthy living with urban amenities that blend with nature. The developer spent over RM15 million in developing the landscape of the township to ensure that its residents continue to enjoy a clean and healthy environment.

Strategically located on 1,000 acres of prime land in Bandar Nusajaya, it embodies lush tropical greens featuring an aesthetically landscaped neighbourhood park called Pusat Rekreasi Taman Bukit Indah.

The developer has also built a RM10 million clubhouse, Kelab Indah, which features a swimming pool, gymnasium, reading room and badminton hall, to provide sports and recreational amenities and facilities for its residents.
