SPECIAL STAMPS TO MARK LAUNCH OF KLIA EXPRESS SERVICE

KUALA LUMPUR, April 10 (Bernama) -- Pos Malaysia will issue special stamps to mark the launch of the Klia Express service by the Prime Minister, Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad, on Saturday.

Pos Malaysia Deputy General Manager (Philately Division) Zakariah Md Sam said the 30 sen commemorative stamps and 50 sen stamps in two designs would be sold to the public from April 13 onwards.

The stamps of 30mm x 40mm size followed the international stamp album standard size, he said.

He said the stamps were printed in Watermarked-Phosphor Coated paper through the lithographic process by Percetakan Nasional Sdn Bhd.

He said 2.5 million 30 sen and one million 50 sen stamps had been printed.

Zakariah said two sheets of mini stamps priced at RM2 each depicting the Klia Express at Salak Tinggi Station and at KL Central Station would also be sold to the public from April 13.

First Day covers at 30 sen each were also being sold from April 6 in conjunction with the launch of the Klia Express, he told reporters.

A special souvenir edition depicting all past Yang di-Pertuan Agong and their period of reign starting from the first Yang di-Pertuan Agong Tuanku Abdul Rahman will also be issued in conjunction with the installation of the 12th Yang di-Pertuan Agong Tuanku Syed Sirajuddin Tuanku Syed Putra Jamalullail on April 25.
