## The struggle of patriots in Anugerah

This play highlights the importance of remembering the country's past and learning about the struggle of patriots in the fight for independence.

Directed by Rosminah Tahir - whose directorial credits include Lantai T. Pinky, experimental theatre A Modern Woman, Cik Rose and Malam Haram - Anugerah is based on the novel of the same title by Zaharah Nawawi.

The novel is about the Malay struggles in Umno during pre-independence days. First staged in 1996, it was restaged later in the same year with a more solid storyline.
