`No to 929' drive to continue, says Kit Siang

SEREMBAN, Sun. - The DAP will continue with its "No to 929" campaign indefinitely to create greater awareness among the people on what it is, national chairman Lim Kit Siang said today.

He added that the majority of the people still did not know anything about the campaign.

Lim said that as far as the DAP was concerned, the campaign was not seditious.

Speaking after distributing "No to 929" leaflets at the Seremban wet market here, Lim said the DAP had a long way to go to make the people realised the objectives of its campaign.

The leaflet refers to the date (Sept 29, 2001) when Umno president and Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad declared the country an Islamic nation.
