DNT TO SHARE E-GOVERNMENT EXPERIENCE AT CONFERENCE IN MOROCCO

KUALA LUMPUR, May 28 (Bernama) -- Dagang Net Technologies Sdn Bhd (DNT), a pioneer and specialist in managing port and customs-related e-transactions in Malaysia, will share its extensive experience in implementing e-government applications at the e-Government 2002 Conference-Expo at Rabat, Morocco from today until Thursday.
