VIETNAMESE DEPUTY PREMIER CALLS ON DR MAHATHIR

PUTRAJAYA, Aug 26 (Bernama) -- Vietnamese deputy premier Nguyen Tan Dzung, currently on a four-day visit to Malaysia, today called on Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad at his office here.

Tan Dzung who is leading an 11-member delegation including three ministers arrived here yesterday for the visit, on the invitation of his Malaysian counterpart Datuk Seri Abdullah Ahmad Badawi.
