Lectures for young professionals

KUALA LUMPUR, Tues. - Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad will launch a series of lectures on topics ranging from the economy to government policies with a talk on the Vision 2020 concept tomorrow.

The Prime Minister will speak on Realising Vision 2020: Where do we stand today? at 8pm at the Mandarin Oriental Hotel.

The series is being organised by The Young Professionals Chamber Malaysia (Promuda) and the National Economic Action Council. Some 70 lectures have been planned for the next three years.
