

'It is an honour for Perlis women'

KANGAR, Tues. — The appointment of Arau MP and State Wanita Umno chief Datuk Mastika Junaidah Husin as Women and Family Development Ministry Parliamentary Secretary was described as a “timely move to further boost the morale of Perlis women”.

State Wanita Umno deputy chief Azihani Ali said the appointment also underlined the recognition and honour granted to the women’s wing in the State.

Born in Kuala Kurau, Perak, she holds a diploma in agriculture from Universiti Putra Malaysia and had served as **Mada** senior assistant agriculture officer and Pertubuhan Peladang **Mada** general manager.

She is married to Ramli Ahmad and they have two children, Riza Fahmi, 25, and Julie Azlina, 24.

She is also the chairman of Malaysia Handicraft Corporation, **Kon**sortium Indah Perlis, Tenaga Cable Industries, Batu Bara Sdn Bhd, **Bernas Perdana** and Jasmine Food Corporation.
