

# Gerakan to ask for *STAR 20.7.2003* more-seats in Penang

**KUALA LUMPUR:** Gerakan will request for more seats in Penang following the redelineation of the electoral boundaries by the Election Commission.

Cerakan president Datuk Seri Dr Lim Keng Yaik said the party had studied in detail the new boundaries and would forward its request at the appropriate Barisan Nasional supreme council meeting.

“The focus (of Gerakan’s request) of course, will be Penang. But we cannot say how many (seats) and where

because it is part of our strategy,” he said after launching the party Satu Academy at its headquarters in Cheras yesterday.

Dr Lim also said Gerakan would hold its annual conference on Aug 24.

“The conference will focus on the Prime Minister because this is expected to be the last conference opened by Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad,” he said after opening Satu Academy for the party cadres at its headquarters in Cheras yesterday.
