KUCHING, Mon. — Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad heads a list of recipients of awards and honours to be conferred in conjunction with Sarawak's 40th anniversary celebration tomorrow. The Prime Minister will receive the Darjah Satria Bintang Sarawak (First Class).

Toh Puan Norkiah, wife of Yang di-Pertua Negeri Tun Abang Muhammad Salahuddin and Deputy Prime Minister Datuk Seri Abdullah Ahmad Badawi will receive the Datuk Patinggi Bintang Kenyalang (DP),

which carries the title "Datuk Patinggi".

International Trade and Industry Minister Datuk Seri Rafidah Aziz, Works Minister Datuk Seri S. Samy Vellu and Agriculture Minister Datuk Effendi Norwawi are among 11 people to receive the Panglima Negera Bintang Sarawak (PNBS), which carries the title "Datuk Seri".
