

Give ACA a chance: Mahathir

KUALA LUMPUR The Anti-Corruption Agency (ACA) should be given the chance to prove its capability in solving cases, including those involving government leaders.

Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad said yesterday, people must trust the ACA and let it prove its case.

"ACA has taken action against many who are leaders in the (political) party, they took the cases to court," he said during a visit to Kraftangan Malaysia.

He was commenting on DAP chairman Lim Kit Siang's questioning of the credibility of the ACA in dealing with the case of former transport minister Datuk Seri Dr Ling Liong Sik and his son Ling Hee Leong.

Mahathir said for Lim, everything is political as he is not concerned with the question of law, the right and the wrong.
