## **Malaysians told to invest in Namibia**

EZULWINI (Swaziland): Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad wants Malaysian corporate players to invest in Namibia now that they are in a better position to undertake reverse investments following recovery from the 1997/98 financial crisis.

“We had a lot of plans before the currency crisis to work in Namibia, but because of the crisis, we were not able to carry out those plans,” he told reporters after bilateral talks with Namibian President Dr Sam Nujoma on the sidelines of the on-going Global 2003 Smart Partnership International Dialogue here on Thursday

He said that among the areas which are potentially lucrative are the construction sector, farming, fishing, mining of precious stones, copper mining, as well as oil and gas exploration.
