

# Express your gratitude to Dr M in a postcard

**SEREMBAN:** The state Hokkien Association has printed some 20,000 "thank you" postcards to Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad who will be retiring next month.

State MCA Youth deputy chief Loh Seng Kok said the initiative was part of the association's month-long campaign to invite the people, especially those residing in the state, to express their feelings for Dr Mahathir.

The postcards are addressed to the association which will

collect them and present them to the Prime Minister.

It says "Thank You, Dr Mahathir" coupled with his picture and landmarks such as the Petronas Twin Towers, KL Tower, Putrajaya administration building and the national car.

The reverse side contains the sender's name, identity card number, address and some space for a personal message.

"We feel that this initiative is timely to show our appreciation to Dr Mahathir for his immense contributions to the

people and the country over the past 22 years," Loh told reporters at the launching of the association's "Thank You, Dr Mahathir" campaign at Seremban Parade here on Monday.

Loh said they would enlist the help of youth associations to distribute the postcards.
