

Berjaya Times Square eyes 3m visitors a month

KUALA LUMPUR: When Berjaya Times Square Kuala Lumpur officially opens its doors on Sept 29, it hopes to achieve an impressive target of three million visitors a month.

Berjaya Group Bhd and Berjaya Times Square Sdn Bhd chairman Tan Sri Vincent Tan said he is confident of achieving this target.

"It is one number we are confident

of achieving," he said after a signing ceremony for tenants and service providers and the launch of Cosmo's World Theme Park mascots yesterday.

The goal seems to be within reach, thanks to the complex's various attractions - the country's largest indoor theme park being just one.

The largest development of its kind in the Asia Pacific, Berjaya Times Square will feature more than 900 specialty stores, 1,200 luxury service suites, 70 restaurants and cafes, 56 bowling lanes, nine-screen cine-

mas, and Malaysia's first Imax 3D theatre.

The building, with a built-up floor area of 7.5 million sq ft, is the world's largest project undertaken in a single phase.

Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad is scheduled to officially open the complex on Sept 29.

Earlier, Tan and Domestic Trade and Consumer Affairs Minister Tan Sri Muhyiddin Yassin witnessed the signing ceremony for the anchor tenants to the complex.
