

PM expresses views on Suu Kyi

NUSA DUA: Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad said yesterday he had expressed Malaysia's view on the issue of pro-democracy leader Aung San Suu Kyi, who is under house arrest, to his counterpart, Gen Khin Nyunt.

He said Khin Nyunt explained to him what was happening in Myanmar and the "Road to Democracy and Reconciliation"

plan that the military-led country had started to implement.

"Malaysia is a good friend of Myanmar and we will try our best to be helpful towards Myanmar," he told Malaysian journalists after meeting the general, who called on him at the hotel where they are staying for the two-day Asean+3 (China, South Korea and Japan) summit beginning today.
