

Opposition lodges police reports

KUALA LUMPUR: Youth leaders from three opposition parties have lodged separate police reports against Tun Dr Mahathir Mohamad and his former Cabinet members in 15 cities and towns throughout the nation.

In the police reports lodged yesterday, the parties urged the police to investigate some 70 allegations of wrongdoing including corruption and abuse of power by Dr Mahathir over his 22 years as Prime Minister.

In the capital, a police report was lodged at 5pm by Parti Keadilan Nasional Youth chief Mohd Ezam Mohd Noor and PAS Youth chief Salahuddin Ayub at the Dang Wangi police station here.

About 50 supporters, including former Internal Security Act detainees Tian Chua and Abdul Ghani Haron, gathered outside the police station as the two lodged the reports. Representatives from Parti Rakyat Malaysia were also present.
