BN, OPPOSITION LEADERS STAND UNITED AGAINST WAR

SEREMBAN, March 25 (Bernama) -- The solidarity between Barisan Nasional (BN) and opposition party leaders, in condemning United States' attack on Iraq, proved they are of one voice in support of universal peace.
