DR MAHATHIR'S VISIT UNCOVERS NEW BUSINESS OPPORTUNITIES

STOCKHOLM, Sept 28 (Bernama) -- The Prime Minister's recent visit to Sweden uncovered new business opportunities and enhanced networking between Malaysian and Swedish businessmen, Chairman of Agritasia Indah Sdn Bhd, Salim Sulaiman said today.

He was among the Malaysian businessman accompanying Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad during the Prime Minister's three-day official visit to Sweden earlier this week.

Salim told Bernama that during the three-day visit he met with representatives of Swedish companies and discussed several areas of cooperation.

Salim, 44, said that Agritasia Indah would hold follow-up meetings in Kuala Lumpur in the very near future.

Agritasia Indah, incorporated 12 years ago and registered with the Ministry of Finance and the Ministry of International Trade and Industry had been actively investing in Malaysian companies listed on the Kuala Lumpur Stock Exchange.

Salim said that if the deal with Swedish companies materialised, Agritasia Indah would be taking a step ahead in its vision to venture outside Malaysia and be a global investor.

"After 12 years, Agritasia Indah is planning to invest in big companies in the coming years either in Malaysia or overseas," he said.
