DR MAHATHIR VISITS KUALA KEDAH MARINA HARBOUR

KUALA KEDAH, Feb 8 (Bernama) -- The Prime Minister, Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad, today inspected the progress on the RM26 million Kuala Kedah Marina Harbour project now under construction here.

He was briefed by BF Infra Sdn Bhd Operations Manager Ahmad Kamal Yaacob. BF Infra, which is developing the project, belongs to the Business Focus group.

Dr Mahathir also took a boat ride to view the project from the sea.

Ahmad Kamal later told reporters that 65 per cent of the project had been completed to date. Work started in June last year and is scheduled for completion by this April.

The project at the 16-hectare site near the Kuala Kedah Ferry Terminal will include a club house and bays which can accommodate 44 boats and yachts, up to 30 metres in length, at any one time.

Asked about the Prime Minister's reaction on the progress, Ahmad Kamal said Dr Mahathir was happy but he hoped the facility could accommodate mega yachts which were more than 30-metres in length.
