MALAYSIA'S SUCCESS DUE TO POWER-SHARING FORMULA OF BN, SAYS ABDULLAH

KUALA LUMPUR, Sept 20 (Bernama) -- Datuk Seri Abdullah Ahmad Badawi has attributed Malaysia's success to the power-sharing formula of the Barisan Nasional (BN).
