MALAYSIA CONGRATULATES GRENADA ON INDEPENDENCE DAY

KUALA LUMPUR, Feb 7 (Bernama) -- The Yang di-Pertuan Agong Tuanku Syed Sirajuddin Putra Jamalullail has sent a congratulatory message to Grenada Governor General Sir Daniel Williams on the country's 29th Independence Day today.

Wisma Putra said Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad had also sent a similar message to his counterpart Keith Mitchell with the hope that the country would continue to enjoy peace and prosperity.
