GOOD WEATHER EXPECTED FOR LIMA

LANGKAWI, Sept 30 (Bernama) -- The Meteorological Services Department has forecast good weather for the whole duration of the Langkawi International Maritime and Aerospace (LIMA) 2003 exhibition beginning today.

This will enable visitors to have a clear view of the aerial demonstrations throughout the six-day exhibition.

According to a spokesman of the Pulau Langkawi Meteorological Station, clear sky was expected during most of the mornings, while the temperature was expected to be between 24 and 33 degrees Celsius.

He said although the afternoons were expected to be cloudy, rain might fall only in one or two areas from today until Friday.

The weather, however, was expected to be bright throughout Saturday, he told Bernama here today.

LIMA `03 was launched by Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad at the Mahsuri International Exposition Centre (MIEC) at Padang Matsirat, the venue for the aerial segment.

The maritime segment is being held at Awana Porto Malai, in the Mukim of Kedawang located about 10 kilometres from MIEC.
