MALAYSIA SET TO BE A NEW LEADER IN CLEAN ELECTRIC VEHICLE TECHNOLOGY

CYBERJAYA, Sept 29 (Bernama) -- Malaysia is set to be a new leader in clean electric vehicle technology with the usage of non-flammable metal fuel produced by InventQjaya Sdn Bhd, its chairman and chief executive officer, Dr Sadeg Mustafa Faris said.

"To start with, we will have a fleet of 20 cars called Malaysia eVictory (MeeVictory) and 150 electronic scooters to facilitate transportation here and Putrajaya within the next 12 months," he told reporters after a media briefing on IQJ technologies here today.

He said IQJ would carry out a test run on the MeeVictory from Cyberjaya to Bukit Kayu Hitam on Oct 11, in conjunction with the official inauguration of IQJ's new state-of-the-art laboratory by Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad.

IQJ, a joint-venture between the Malaysian government and Reveo Inc of the USA, is a mega research and development (R&D) laboratory designed to speed up the innovation of a world-class knowledge economy for Malaysia.

Dr Sadeg, who is Reveo Inc. chairman, president and chief executive officer said the cost of these cars would be much cheaper compared to other regular cars.

"We hope MeeVictory will create a new world record by being able to run to between 500km to 600km compared to Reveo Inc eVictory which runs up to 340km without refuelling or recharge," he said.

He said eVictory created by Reveo Inc was listed in the Guinness Book of record.

"And we hope our Malaysian designed MeeVictory is able to break our Reveo Inc's record," Dr Sadeg added.

He also said that this metal power could be used in the Perodua cars. Non-flammable metal fuel is an innovative energy solutions for humanity. It is the world's first, environmentally friendly, low cost and with higher power density. -- BERNAMA
