"MINDA PERDANA MENTERI" MADE A COMPULSORY SUBJECT IN UiTM

KUALA PILAH, Sept 16 (Bernama) -- The book "Minda Perdana Menteri", a collection of speeches of Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad, will be made a compulsory subject for all students of Universiti Teknologi MARA (UiTM).

UiTM Vice-Chancellor Prof Datuk Seri Dr Ibrahim Abu Shah said it would be part of the university's curriculum.

"This was decided by the UiTM Senate recently as we want all students and lecturers to study the Prime Minister's ideas covering various fields," he said at the presentation of the book, compiled by UiTM, at its Negeri Sembilan Campus here today.

State Social, Community Development and Women Affairs Committee Chairman Datuk Norhayati Omar, who officiated the function, said Malaysia was now well known internationally due to efforts of Dr Mahathir.

She said that even countries like the United States and Britain had acknowledged development achieved by Malaysia which was viewed by many Islamic countries as a model state.

In BANDAR JENGKA, Dr Ibrahim said the subject would be compulsory to some 100,000 students in 14 branch campuses nationwide.

"In this connection, it is suggested that all lecturers get a copy of the book," he said at the presentation of the book to Deputy Pahang Menteri Besar Datuk Tan Mohd Aminuddin Ishak at the Pahang Campus of UiTM.

He said the book could serve as a useful reference for the students in future.

"Dr Mahathir's leadership has been proven and should be emulated," he said.
