MMCKK-COMPLEX

MMCKK WILL BUILD MULTIPURPOSE COMPLEX

KOTA BAHARU, May 24 (Bernama) -- The Malaysian Malay Chamber of Commerce Kelantan (MMCKK) will build a multipurpose complex worth RM25 million which will provide various facilities for its members.

Its president, Nik Abdul Rahman Nik Taib, said that the complex would be constructed on a 0.6 ha land at Kampung Sireh, here, in the immediate term.

"The 14-storey complex has facilities like a main hall, conference room, meeting room, shop and office lots under one roof," he said at the chamber's annual general meeting here today, which was officiated by Datuk Zahidi Zainal Abidin, political secretary to Second Finance Minister Datuk Dr Jamaludin Jarjis. Zahidi had represented the second Finance Minister.

Nik Abdul Rahman said that the Kelantan chamber now has 1,035 members who are involved in various business activities.

He said that the chamber also plans to get its members to be involved in the breeding of lobsters on a 480 ha site in Pasir Mas, which has been identified as a potential area for such breeding.

Commenting on the new economic package, which was announced by Prime Minister Datuk Seri Dr Mahathir Mohamad on Wednesday, he said that the Kelantan chamber welcomed the move and is confident that it could help to boost entrepreneurs' activities.

He urged the chamber members to set up a business network and those with ample capital to help their counterparts to expand their businesses. --
